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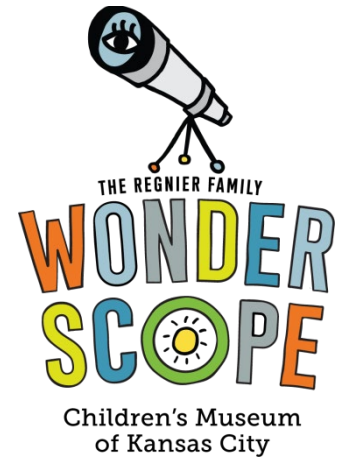
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## **It's Not *Just* Fun & Games!**

**New series of videos demonstrate the essential skills that are developed during play**

Kansas City, MO (January 14, 2022) The Regnier Family Wonderscope Children's Museum of Kansas City recently unveiled a series of short videos that demonstrate the valuable skills children develop while engaging in certain play activities — both in the museum and at home.

The new *Knowledge Bites* videos were created by Wonderscope's team of educational specialists to provide caregivers of young children with greater insight to the specific development that takes place during play. Each video features children at play within Wonderscope's exhibits and is narrated by the museum's program staff.
